

DERRY PUBLIC LIBRARY
Study Room Use Policy
Amended February 9, 2026

1. The Derry Public Library (“DPL”) has three (3) study rooms on the adult level. The study rooms can be used by one (1) to four (4) people at a time. No food or beverages (except plain water in a covered container) are allowed in the study rooms. Electrical outlets for personal computers are available.
2. Patrons may sign up at the Information Desk to work in a study room for a two (2) hour period on a first come, first served basis. Additional time may be granted if no other patron has signed up at the Information Desk. Study rooms may not be reserved prior to the day of use.
3. Students in the eighth (8th) grade or below may not use the rooms between the hours of 2:00pm and 5:00pm.
4. Court-ordered supervised visitations, which are ordered for the safety of the participants, are prohibited in DPL’s study rooms.
5. The study rooms must be vacated fifteen (15) minutes prior to DPL’s closing time.
6. Violation of the DPL policies may result in revocation of use of the study rooms by the Board of Trustees.
